We extend our prayers to all Cottagers, Visitors, families and friends during a time of great uncertainty. The Coronavirus represents a significant challenge to all of us as a nation and also here at South Seaville Camp Meeting. We are clearly in uncharted territory. The NJ Governor has instructed the residents to remain at home and limit travel (food, medical items, etc.) The number of confirmed Coronavirus cases in New Jersey has risen from 15 on March 10th to 2,860 on March 24th.

With a first focus on health and safety, in the current environment with limits on travel and ability to congregate, we will postpone turning on the water for the seasonal cottages and maintain locked common buildings. There are no events planned in the coming weeks. We will provide updates on camp status in subsequent communications.
